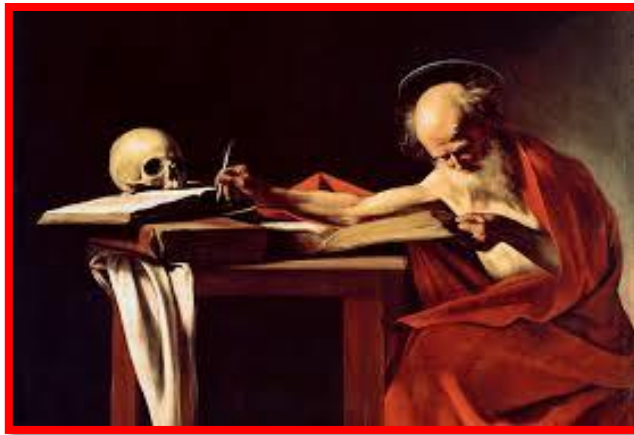

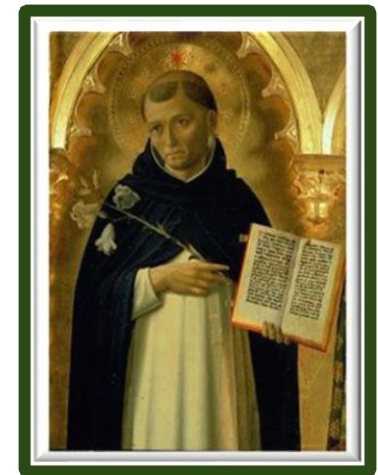

Spring, 2020

In the Spring semester (January 20-April 6, 2020), we offer a twelve-week sabbatical with 15 hours of class a week and a nine-day pilgrimage to the Holy Land (cost is additional). There is also the option of celebrating Mass in the Station Churches of Rome during Lent.

COST:

Fall, 2019:

Module 1 – \$6,000 (includes pilgrimage to Umbria)

Module 2 – \$4,500

Module 3 – \$6,500 (includes bus tour to Florence)

Participants may choose to attend any combination of modules above.

Spring, 2020: \$13,000

The three-month sabbatical and all of the modules include: airport pick up and drop off; full room and board within short walking distance of St. Peter's Basilica; a five-day priest retreat (except in Module 2); the opportunity for communal/individual prayer (Daily Mass, Liturgy of the Hours, Holy Hour, Confession); classes taught by expert instructors from Rome and beyond (approximately 15 hours per week); Wednesday General Audience with the Holy Father (except in Modules Two and Three); free travel weekends (Friday afternoon to Sunday evening); organized and optional visits to places of interest in and around Rome; closing Mass and banquet.

The Institute for Continuing Theological Education is housed in its own quarters, on the campus of the Pontifical North American College on the Janiculum Hill, overlooking the Vatican and much of Rome. Completely renovated in 2010, Casa O'Toole has its own chapel, classroom, lounge, dining room and wifi network.

Each private room is fully furnished, including a bathroom and its own heat and air conditioning. Priests have use of the College's library, brand new fitness center, and money-exchange services.
